

The Wave Stitch Crohook Scarf

Class Description:

This pattern stitch for crohook crochet (a double-ended crochet hook) came to me from Mary Lou Fisk through a mutual friend, Carol Ruplinger. The stitch creates Tunisian Lace and gives a nice lacey, open feel with pleasing drape. We've named it the Wave Stitch since it would look great in school colors.

- Yarn: 1 skein each of DK or Sport Weight in Color A and Color B.
- Crohook size G, H, or I at least 12" long (The larger the hook the more open the scarf.)
